Is the information on the page useful for your project?

Would you have gotten more information from an encyclopedia?

Does the page lead you to some other good information? (links)

Does the author of the page present information you think is wrong?

Does some information contradict information you found elsewhere?

Does the author tell you about him/herself?

Do you feel the author is knowledgeable about the topic?

Are you positive the information is true?

What can you do to prove the information is true?
