Church—Wendy Batti reported that Msgr. Harguindeguy has requested that she see to it that the names of all capital campaign donors be included in the Tuesday packet. In his absence no additional report was given.

PTO—Margie Olson will serve as President and be attending these meetings. The PTO P&L reflects a cash balance of \$14,740. The carnival is expected to be the most successful to date. There will be six new rides and new entertainment options. Ticket sales are brisk and right on target. The golf tournament is slated for the 22nd of October and the Halloween Party needs a chairperson. Lisa Garber will oversee Grizzlies night this spring as well as a Father's coffee and donuts morning.

Principal's—Shawn Carey welcomed all for the first meeting of the year. He noted that there are new personnel on campus- Kim Boyer is in charge of Campus Care, Sara Meyer, girls PE and support staff; Lorna Manning is the new school counselor; and Joan Cramer is the new reading tutor who will be on campus ½ time 5 days /week, her salary is paid by the PTO club. Laurence Yopez is now a full-time janitor.

Survey results from the laptop program reflect that parents are supportive of the idea. Staff from Alta Sierra middle school will mentor St. Anthony's teachers in the use of laptops in the classroom. With the addition of the laptops Mr. Olson is now responsible for 200 computers.

PTO contributions to the school this past year totaled \$80,346.00. PTO efforts enabled students to benefit in a number of areas that otherwise would have gone unfunded.

Kim Cochran just finished her Masters in teaching and Administrative credential. Title II part A funding is allowing one teacher to complete her credential as well as allowing three teachers to complete their Masters degrees.
